- 2. Pray an Our Father.
- 3. Prayer three Hail Marys and one Glory Be.
- 4. Announce the mystery and pray the Our Father.
- 5. Pray ten Hail Marys and one Glory Be.
- 6. Pray the Hail, Holy Queen.

# THE APOSTLES' CREED I believe in God,
