# HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and pray the Apostles' Creed.
2. Pray an Our Father.
3. Prayer three Hail Marys and one Glory Be.
4. Announce the mystery and pray the Our Father.
5. Pray ten Hail Marys and one Glory Be.
6. Pray the Hail, Holy Queen.

## THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God,

the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and life everlasting.  
Amen.
